REPOSITORY REFERENCE:	ARP 124 •ARP124.1 Cell-free culture supernatant (H9). •ARP124.2 Infected H9 cells.
ORIGIN:	Gambia 1988
CHARACTERISTICS :	Isolated from a patient with AIDS related complex. Highly sensitive to neutralisation by antibodies in HIV-2 positive sera, and cross neutralised by some HIV-1 antisera. Grows slowly and produces syncytia in primary cultures.
CELL LINE :	Н9
CULTURE MEDIUM :	RPMI 1640, 90% foetal calf serum,10%
PROPAGATION :	Chronically infected cells will require sub-culturing at 2-4 day intervals.
STORAGE :	Liquid nitrogen
